

[Main points of facts of suspected crime]

A. Violation of Act on Special Cases Concerning the Punishment, etc. of Sexual Violence Crimes

No one is allowed to distribute, sell, lend, provide, or publicly display pictures that show someone else's body parts against the person's will and induce sexual desire or cause sexual humiliation, or take said pictures with a camera or a similar device. Suspect(s) logged in with an unknown ID, on an unknown date and at an unknown place and publicly displayed video clips of the victims' body parts on 17 websites including jmscult.com.

B. Violation of Act on Promotion of Information and Communication Network Utilization and information Protection, etc.(Defamation)

Suspect(s) logged in with an unknown ID, on an unknown date and at an unknown place and posted the pixelated video clips or captured pictures of the naked victims or the links to the video clips or pictures on websites including jmscult.com. The suspect(s) defamed the victims' reputation by publicly posting their exposed bodies via information and communication networks with an intension to slander the victims.

Updated process as of Nov. 10th, 2015
